Commercial Driver's License

[CONTINUING EDUCATION]



Add mileage to your professional future by training to earn your Kansas commercial driver's license (CDL). This specialized training can lead to a variety of career options from driving a bus to hauling goods across the country. It's a short-term investment that can bring long-term benefits.

LEARNING AT WASHBURN TECH

This four-week continuing education course begins with an indepth overview of the Kansas Commercial Driver's License manual, and includes a physical, drug screen and testing for instructional permits. Students spend time in the classroom and behind the wheel. The classroom location for this course is Washburn Tech East at 2014 SE Washington St.

Classroom training covers federal motor carrier regulations, daily logs and equipment of the trade. Students learn how to read and interpret control systems, perform vehicle inspections and exercise basic control. In addition, instruction covers shifting, backing and docking the vehicle along with managing speed and space relations. Students learn how to identify potential driving hazards and perform emergency maneuvers. They also learn to identify and adjust to difficult and extreme driving conditions, handle and

document cargo, address environmental issues, plan trips and use effective communications.

Students will hear presentations from several industry professionals, including placement presentations with major trucking companies. Attending full-day, students can complete the course in four weeks.

CLASS HOURS AND COST

Washburn Tech offers nine cohorts of this course throughout the year. Students attend class from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, for four weeks. They accumulate 160 hours of classroom and driving time.

The cost of this course is \$4,000. To enroll or receive information, call 785.670.3353.

FAQ'S

IS FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE?

There is no financial aid available through Washburn Tech. Check with various state agencies in your home state for programs to assist you in paying tuition. In Kansas, you can check with Heartland Works, WIA, Workforce Development, Unemployment Office, VA, DCF, SER and Voc-Rehab. Other states have similar programs. Call us with your funding questions.

IS HOUSING AVAILABLE?

Housing is available in Topeka. The cost is \$850 for four weeks. This is based on multiple occupancy, meaning that you will probably share an apartment with another trucking student. Each apartment has a refrigerator, stove, microwave and coffeepot. There is cable television. Each apartment has two full beds and bed linens are furnished. You can check in the day the class begins.

WHAT ARE CLASS HOURS?

This four-week program is from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

DO I NEED A PERMIT BEFORE CLASS STARTS?

WHAT IS THE INSTRUCTOR/STUDENT RATIO?

As a general rule, each instructor will have three students or less per truck.

DO I NEED TO TAKE THE D.O.T. PHYSICAL PRIOR TO THE START OF CLASS?

You do not need to take the physical prior to attending. Do not take a drug screening on your own. The drug screen and physical are included in the tuition cost and will be administered by the school.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO ATTEND?

The only requirements needed for the college is a valid driver's license, online application and must be 18 before the start of the course. The online application is located on our website, www.washburntech.edu. Once those items are submitted, the student will pay an enrollment fee.
