If you are creative and enjoy using your imagination, graphics is a perfect career for you. The field combines artistic skill with computers and technology. Learn how creativity, computers and technology work together to provide a high-quality image for an organization or business.

LEARNING AT WASHBURN TECH

Our program provides instruction on the basics of graphic design software such as Adobe InDesign, Adobe Illustrator and Adobe Photoshop through tutorials, hands-on activities, client-driven projects and internship opportunities. Attending full-day, you can complete the program in two semesters, while half-day students can complete the program in four semesters. Upon completion, you will earn a 48-credit-hour technical certificate and be eligible to complete an associate degree or more advanced degrees at Washburn University.

JOB AND SALARY OUTLOOK

The U.S. Department of Labor expected employment of graphic designers to grow 3 percent from 2020 to 2030 as demand continues to increase from advertisers and computer design firms. Competition, however,

is high as many talented people are attracted to this career. According to the Kansas Department of Labor, the average salary for an entry-level graphic designer in 2022 was \$17.02 an hour or \$35,410 annually. The average was \$23.37 an hour or \$48,610 annually.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to take the Accuplacer exam and score a 4 in both reading and math. Other assessments or college coursework can be accepted in place of Accuplacer. See a recruiter for details. You also must complete an application and submit transcripts.

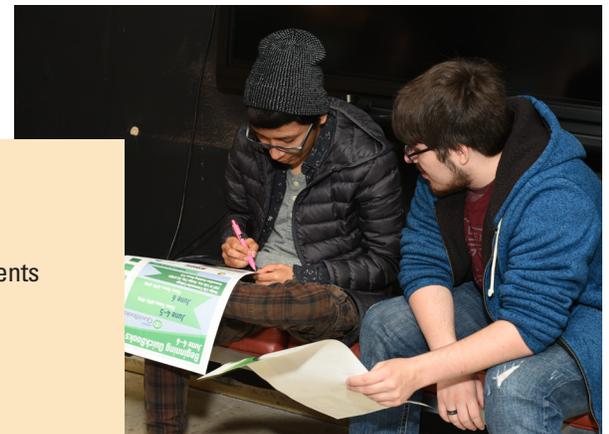

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

GRAPHIC DESIGN I

Summarizes the role of graphic communications in a technological society and covers the fundamental principles and elements of design and layout

PAGE LAYOUT

Introduces composition techniques and procedures utilizing page layout software such as Adobe InDesign

COLOR COMPOSITION

Covers color theories and composition as related to imaging rules of creative element placement and design

GRAPHIC DESIGN II

Covers the intermediate principles/elements of design and general layout

VECTOR BASED GRAPHICS

Focuses on vector graphics and their use for production; skill development in the use of the tools and transformation options of Adobe Illustrator

DIGITAL PRINTING

Principles of digital imaging technology and the different types of equipment and methods involved in electronic image capture

GRAPHIC DESIGN III

Covers the advanced principles and elements of design and layout in the production of visual images

RASTER BASED GRAPHICS

Covers image composition techniques and procedures utilizing raster graphics software like Photoshop

PAPER & BINDERY

Covers the different types of paper and other substrates used for printing in the graphics industry

GRAPHIC DESIGN IV

Further mastery of a tracer system and interview skills

TYPOGRAPHY

Learn to manipulate the visual form of language to enrich and control its meaning

PRODUCTION GRAPHICS

Provides students with an on-the-job experience in a graphics setting; may include on-campus virtual internship, job shadowing or off-campus internship

PORTFOLIO PREPARATION

Focuses on business operations and job management techniques; students learn interview techniques, how to prepare a resume and digital/physical portfolio
