# PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

### Students are required to provide proof of the following health/vaccine requirements before the first day of class:

- Obtain a physical with a licensed health care provider, and provide proof of a TB test (less than six months old). Please use the Physical form provided by Washburn Tech once accepted into the program.
- DPT, MMR x2, Hepatitis B (series of shots), Polio, and Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccines, (and a Flu shot in October).
- COVID Vaccination (Must have two vaccinations plus on booster if vaccinated before or on August 2021)
- Current CPR certification for the HealthCare Provider.
- Valid Health Insurance (must remain active during the entire program).
- Eye Exam is required and must include documented color blindness testing
- 12 Panel Drug Screen
