Students who would like to earn their GED diploma may take any of the health aide programs above as part of Accelerating Opportunity: Kansas (AO-K). The program allows individuals to work toward their GED while receiving technical training. Tuition costs are covered by the Kansas Board of Regents. The student only pays a \$30 materials fee and the cost of taking four tests to earn the GED. Students who enroll in the programs above but already have their GED diploma may qualify for financial assistance.
