**Please Note:** You will be given a diploma cover at the ceremony; only students attending the ceremony will receive diploma covers. Certificates and final transcripts will be available approximately 6-8 weeks after the end of the semester. After final grades are entered, a review is conducted of all student records. To earn a certificate, you must achieve a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.0 or better, achieve grades of "C" or better in all courses within your technical program sequence, and maintain the attendance rate required in your program. All financial obligations must be met prior to the release of certificates or transcripts.
