ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Students must take the entrance exam and score a level 4 on Arithmetic (Math) and a level 4 on Reading Comprehension.
2. After passing the entrance exam at the required levels, please contact Admissions for upcoming class dates and times. Enrollment is first-come, first served.
3. **Fees must be paid in full at time of enrollment.** This course is not eligible for Federal Financial Aid.
4. Students must have a valid/current C.N.A. license in Kansas.
