Required Accuplacer Scores: Level 5 Arithmetic (Math) and Level 5 Reading Comprehension

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Students must take the entrance exam and score a level 5 on Arithmetic (Math) and a level 5 on Reading Comprehension.
2. After passing the entrance exam at the required levels, please contact Admissions for upcoming class dates and times. Class is one semester. Enrollment is first-come, first served.
3. Students must have a valid/current C.N.A. license in Kansas.
4. This course is not eligible for federal financial aid.

OTHER NOTES

1. Students must be 18 years of age or older to take the state C.M.A. exam.
2. Students must take the state exam within one calendar year of the start date of their class.
3. If longer than one calendar year has passed, the student must re-take the entire C.M.A. class to be eligible to take the state exam.
4. Students are required to provide their immunization record that has their current TB test, Tdap, Hep B, MMR, Influenza, and COVID-19 vaccinations. Students should use the health care provider of their choice for this requirement.
5. Students will be required to purchase scrubs from the vendor of their choice. Prices will vary by vendor.
6. Verified Credentials need to be completed prior to Day 1.

Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS), regulations require students to have a social security card to be eligible to take the exam to become a certified Nurse Aide, Home Health Aide and/or Medication Aide in the state of Kansas. Therefore, students enrolling at Washburn Tech in the Nurse Aide, Home Health Aide and/or Medication Aide course(s) must present their social security card on DAY 1. Also, for students enrolling in the Medication Aide course, they must be 18 years of age or older at the time they take the state exam.
