#### ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Students must take the entrance exam and score a level 4 on Arithmetic (Math) and a level 4 on Reading Comprehension.
2. After passing the entrance exam at the required levels, please contact Admissions for upcoming class dates and times. Class length: hours vary. Enrollment is first-come, first served.
3. This course is not eligible for federal financial aid.
4. Students are required to obtain a current Physical, TB test and tetanus booster. Students should use the health care provider of their choice for these requirements.
5. Students will be required to purchase scrubs from the vendor of their choice. Prices will vary by vendor.
6. Washburn Tech reserves the right to make adjustments to a student's account as needed (and/or without prior notice) to ensure accurate schedules and/or billing.
7. Students may also need to purchase supplies such as (but not limited to) pens and/or pencils, notebooks and/or paper, three-ring-binders, etc. These items are purchased by the student at the vendor of their choice.
