ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Students must be 18 years of age or older to enroll in this program. For fall semester must be 18 by October 1. For spring semester must be 18 by March 1. For summer semester must be 18 by June 1.
2. Students must take the entrance exam and score a level 4 on Arithmetic (Math) and a level 4 on Reading Comprehension.
3. Enrollment is first-come, first served.
4. These courses are not eligible for federal financial aid.
5. Washburn Tech reserves the right to make adjustments to a student's account as needed (and/or without prior notice) to ensure accurate schedules and/or billing.
6. Students may also need to purchase supplies such as (but not limited to) pens and/or pencils, notebooks and/or paper, three-ring-binders, etc. These items are purchased by the student at the vendor of their choice.
7. Students will be required to purchase scrubs from the vendor of their choice. Prices will vary by vendor.
