LEARNING AT WASHBURN TECH

Our ADN program is available as a full-time, daytime program with either August or January start dates. Students who successfully complete this 65-credit hour program will earn their Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing and will then be eligible to take the NCLEX-RN licensing exam. Successful completion of the NCLEX-RN enables the graduate to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN). This program is approved by the Kansas State Board of Nursing. Attending full-day, you can complete the program in two semesters.

JOB AND SALARY OUTLOOK

This career forecast is bright due to an aging population and increased demand for healthcare services. Kansas Department of Labor reports the average salary for an entry-level RN is \$29.30 an hour or \$60,939 annually. The average wage is \$36.53 an hour or \$75,977 annually.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for the ADN program must have completed a Kansas approved Practical Nursing program and have an active Kansas LPN License. You must take the **ATI TEAS Assesment**. Students must **earn a composite score of 55 or higher**. Students earning a 55 or higher for PN admission do not need to retake the TEAS. A list of prerequisite coursework is listed in the Admissions packet. Candidates must complete a paper application and submit transcripts.

INTRODUCTORY COLLEGE WRITING

Study of and practice with the processes of writing for college courses

Hybrid course prepares the nurse to provide safe, effective care for the client experiencing mental illness

MATERNAL CHILD NURSING W/PRACTICUM

Hybrid course prepares the nurse to provide safe, effective care for women, newborns and children

HIGH RISK CARE OF THE ADULT W/PRACTICUM (2)

Hybrid course prepares the student to manage patients with acute and chronic complex health alterations

LEADERSHIP FOR THE PROFESSIONAL NURSE

Facilitates the transition of the nursing student into nursing practice

CAPSTONE (1.5)/NCLEX RN REVIEW COURSE

Course allows students to integrate all prior learning to prepare for the NLEX-RN test plan
