LEARNING AT WASHBURN TECH

This course is designed for those wanting to earn a nurse aide certification from the State of Kansas. Based on the state's curriculum. Washburn Tech students receive 45 hours of classroom instruction, 20 hours of lab work and 25 hours of hands-on clinical experience. High school juniors and seniors as well as adults are eligible for this course, which is a prerequisite for the certified medication aide and home health aide courses and the practical nursing program. Upon completion, you will be prepared to take the Nurse Aide Certification exam from the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services. Please note: this shortterm course is not eligible for financial aid or commencement.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CNA

The Nurse Aide (CNA) course is designed for the person seeking work as an entry-level nurse aide under the direct supervision of a licensed practical nurse or registered nurse. It provides the foundation for further education as a Home Health Aide, Certified Medication Aide, Practical Nurse or Surgical Technician.

CNAs may work in a long-term care facility, hospital, doctor's office or other healthcare areas. The course introduces the basic concepts of aging as well as basic nursing skills related to the care of the elderly. Hands-on experience in a clinical setting is an integral part of the course.

Upon completion of the course, students are eligible to become a Certified Nurse Aide after passing the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services exam.
