

Home health aides make a remarkable difference in the lives of the sick, disabled or elderly. They assist other healthcare professionals in maintaining and restoring a client to optimum levels of physical and emotional well-being while allowing that person to stay at home! This quick course moves you from a hospital setting into a residential setting.

LEARNING AT WASHBURN TECH

You must be a CNA to enroll in this part-time course, which offers two hours of credit. The program provides the foundation for more advanced healthcare programs at Washburn Tech such as practical nursing and surgical technology. Upon completion, you will be eligible to earn a home health aide certificate after passing the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services exam. Please note: this short-term course is not eligible for financial aid or commencement.

JOB AND SALARY OUTLOOK

Employment for home health aides is expected to be excellent because of rapid growth in home health care and high replacement needs. U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) expects a job increase of 33 percent from 2020 to 2030. Kansas Department of Labor reports the average salary for a home health aide is \$12.56 an hour or \$26,130 annually.

The average wage is \$13.65 an hour or \$28,036 annually.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

For dual-credit high school students submission of an application, official partial transcript, and consent to enroll form are required. Adult students must complete an application and submit an official copy of all transcripts. Please see an admissions counselor for details.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

HOME HEALTH AIDE

This course is designed for the person seeking to provide direct care services to clients in their home. Home Health Aides assist other healthcare professionals in maintaining and restoring the client to optimum levels of physical and emotional well-being while allowing the client to remain at home.

Upon completion of the course, students are eligible to receive a certificate after passing the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services exam. This is a part-time course. Prerequisite: CNA certified.
