✓ PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS), regulations require students to have a social security card to be eligible to take the exam to become a certified Nurse Aide, Home Health Aide and/or Medication Aide in the state of Kansas. Therefore, students enrolling at Washburn Tech in the Nurse Aide, Home Health Aide and/or Medication Aide course(s) must present their social security card during the application process. • Students are required to obtain a physical and TB test with the licensed health care provider of their choice (less than six (6) months old from the start date of the program). • COVID Vaccination (MUST have two vaccinations plus one booster if vaccinated before or on August 2021). • Students must also provide proof of their last Tetanus booster. • Valid Health Insurance (MUST remain active during the entire program). • Ability to regularly lift 50 or more pounds. 			
✓ UNIFORMS (REQUIRED)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are required to purchase two (2) scrub tops in Caribbean blue and two (2) scrub bottoms in black for this program. Scrubs may be purchased from Similar Mode or from the vendor of the student's choice. Prices will vary by vendor. Similar Mode is located at: 915 SW 6th Ave. Topeka, KS 66606. Phone number is 785-235-0361. • Tennis Shoes – preferred white shoes; if not white shoes they <u>must be clean</u>.
