✓ UNIFORMS (REQUIRED)

✓ PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Proof of the following health/vaccine requirements are required. Washburn Tech has partnered with Verified Credentials to track student health clearance records and conduct pre-entrance background checks and drug screens. Students will be assessed a fee upon signing up on the Verified Credentials website and will be responsible for paying the fee.

- -Current physical and TB skin test
- -Tdap, MMR, Varicella vaccine or titer, Hepatitis B series-first vaccine must have been started, and seasonal Flu shot.
- -Valid health insurance (must remain active during the entire program).
- -COVID Vaccination
- -Current BLS/CPR and healthcare certification.

Students should visit the healthcare provider of their choice for these heath requirements, prices will vary.

All requirements must be completed by the FIFTH day of class. Failure to complete the requirements by the Fifth day of class may result in dismissal from the program.
