UNIFORMS ARE REQUIRED by SEPTEMBER

- Students are required to purchase scrubs (at least four (4) sets are recommended) in steel gray (solid color) and one (1) lab jacket in solid black. Students will have a Washburn Tech patch (that needs to be sewn on scrub top) – patches provided in fees
- Shoes – it is preferred that students have a pair of shoes that are easily cleaned dedicated for the operating room only.
- ID Badge- obtained through Student Services- required for all lab and clinical days

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to provide proof of the following health/vaccine requirements before the first day of class:

- Obtain a physical with a licensed health care provider and provide proof of a TB test (less than six months old). Please use the Physical form provided by Washburn Tech once accepted into the program.
- DPT, MMR x2, Hepatitis B (series of shots), Polio, and Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccines, (and a Flu shot in October).
- Current CPR certification for the HealthCare Provider.
- Valid Health Insurance (must remain active during the entire program).
- Eye Exam is required and must include documented color blindness testing
- 12 Panel Drug Screen
