What is offered?

- Emergency personal care items such as deodorant, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, feminine care supplies (application and valid WU Tech ID required, availability based on annual budget)
- Food items including emergency one-serving Gatorade, one-serving mac-n-cheese, one-serving protein bars (application and valid WU Tech ID required, availability based on annual budget)
- Referral to WU Bods Feeding Bods Food Pantry
- Emergency funds, limited amount (must complete application and valid WU Tech ID required, availability based on need and annual budget)
